Digital resources

The Le@rning Federation (TLF) is making available a substantial number of resources in digital form, which are significant and meaningful on their own, useful for teaching and learning in the six agreed curriculum areas, and not otherwise readily accessible. In contrast to learning objects which have in-built instructional design, the TLF digital resources offer teachers and students the flexibility to design their own learning activities.

Digital resources can be moving image footage, images of documents, line drawings, paintings, or maps; photographs; and audio files of songs and broadcasts.

TLF licenses the items from partner institutions, including the National Film and Sound Archive, National Archives of Australia, National Library of Australia, Museum of New Zealand Te Papa Tongarewa, CSIRO Entomology, Powerhouse Museum, Art Gallery of South Australia, John Curtin Prime Ministerial Library and private individuals.

Description
This is an image of a poster advertising the 1923 silent movie comedy 'The dinkum bloke'. The poster depicts actor Arthur Tauchert as the well-meaning father Bill Davis, dressed as a home (dinkum) working man as a street singer outside a pub, laments the struggle to pull the penniless man's daughter to educate his daughter as a lady.

Educational value
This resource is useful because it

- is advertising a film that realistically tells a portrait of Australian civility and society around Sydney in the 1920s
- introduces a working class character as a hero, an attempt by the filmmaker to bridge the social divide between the working class and the newly responsible/morose class
- represents the Australian male worker as a free and easy type
- uses slang expressions such as 'dinkum' which means genuine, and 'bloke' which refers to a man, in the title of the film, introducing a distinctive brand of Australian humour
- celebrates a film that was considered by experts at the time to be a difficult comedy for the local American imported film - it was released in the UK in 1924 under the title 'A partner in trouble' (which refers to the plot device that one man has someone who has the right to wear a ring).




